

Virtual Volunteers are Ready to Support Students

Whether you are teaching virtually or in a hybrid classroom, our screened and trained volunteers can support your efforts



- Our Virtual America Reads program is a partnership between the teacher and volunteer.
- Teachers provide volunteers with direction, reading materials and support.
- America Reads volunteers are trained to work with 1st through 5th grade students.
- Volunteers connect to your classroom via Zoom or your preferred platform.
- Following your direction, volunteers enter breakout rooms to work on individual skills.
- Using your direction and provided materials, volunteers will engage students in reading, using the strategies you utilize in your classroom, such as predicting, asking clarifying questions and summarizing.
- Teachers share books with students and volunteers or pages can be emailed to the volunteer. Students may also access books from Epic or Raz Kids.
- Volunteers can be available after sessions to provide detailed individual feedback.
