**RSVP improves the lives of vulnerable populations in the community by focusing on education and wellness and by supporting nonprofits through skill-based volunteer programs.**

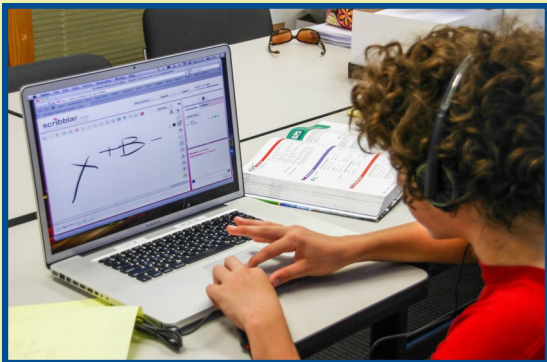

## RSVP Impact Programs

*Directly enhancing the lives of community members*

### Children & Youth

**Family Literacy.** Work with Head Start preschoolers to help develop their reading skills and learn to love books.

**America Reads.** Be a supportive reading coach and help K-4 students to read with more confidence.

**Youth Mentoring.** Mentor a student. Provide support and guidance and encourage positive behavior, resulting in greater academic and life success.

**Tutoring.** Volunteers assist teachers and students through vocational programs, conduct museum tours and judge science fairs.

**STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) Career Presentations.** Professionals with STEM careers visit classrooms inspiring future STEM specialists through hands-on presentations.

### Virtual Tutoring/Learning

**My Free Tutor.** Volunteers work with high school students to improve math proficiency via online tutoring.

**Math Tutoring for Veterans.** My Free Tutor volunteers help to improve math skills of veterans to prepare them to enter college and the workforce.

### Adults and Seniors

**Adult Literacy.** Help increase economic opportunities for adults through GED, ESL and basic literacy tutoring.

**Helping Seniors at Home.** Volunteers provide seniors with in-home support in bookkeeping, shopping and transportation to doctor appointments, all while providing social interaction.

**Medicare Counseling.** APPRISE is a free, confidential public program of the PA Department of Aging. State trained counselors offer advice on Medicare coverage, options and assistance programs.

### Nonprofit Agencies

**Volunteer Executive Consultants.** VEC volunteers are business professionals who help build the management capacity of nonprofits in the region.



## Corporate Partnerships

RSVP engages corporate volunteers with on and off-site projects that unify employees to create good within their communities. Projects are customized and integrate corporate goals and initiatives. STEM employees can inspire career advancement as a role model for students.
