

## Would your student benefit from a mentor?

Our volunteers enhance the student's personal development including self-esteem, building relationships, goal-setting and researching future opportunities.







- Students in grades 3 6 are eligible for our evidence-based program.
- Your student will be matched with a thoroughly screened volunteer mentor and meet virtually, via Zoom sessions.
- The mentor and your child will meet online twice each month after school hours.
- During sessions the pair will get to know each other by sharing family traditions, exploring emotions, managing time and talking about areas of interest.
- Mentors will use e-books and videos pertaining to discussion topics including building skills to handle difficult situations, controlling anger managing anxiety and more.
- Online resources will be provided by the National Mentoring Partnership and others.
